July 12	continued Thursday toward rape land till ten then raked up hay. In PM we hauled in 3 loads put on with loader I went to meeting of managers at night in vestry. Town full of Orangemen returned from Guelph where they had a parade. at night got salmon at Armstrongs 15 cts
Paid Mr Gass in full to date \$2.00

Fine in AM rained heavy in PM thunder and
lightning warm day. I didn't get to church to-day
I drove Bella and Sophia down to church in AM. Jim
McSellar Georgina Sparks and Margaret Newton came
down to town for want bed himself in evening.
Mr Williamson of Elora preached in AM and Mr
McVicar at night.
