Linnine iron 10cts meat Mills 30cts paid
Steel axe \$4.47 also dry goats 49 at Steel.

Fine sunny warm day. Mr Gass
here all day hoeing turnips. We cultivated

rest of cut hay 3/4 load to other barn one here.
Father up in evening. Willie down town
at night got salmon at Armstrongs 15cts
Paid Mr Gass in full to date \$2.00

Mr. Lella Georgina Spink and Margaret Newton came

Mc Vicar at night.
