Thursday

Cloudy drizzling day very wet weather We made whiffletrees etc to-day We have 29 chicks out Geo Armstrong died this morning

Friday

Rainy heavy last night and this morning stopped in A.M., cloudy day. We put load hay on waggon other barn A.M. In P.M. Willie took it down gave 790 lbs to Mrs. M<sup>rs</sup> Mitchell and 1180 to Bill Mutch weighing 10 cts. Messrs Crow and Sanderson called in P.M. another up in P.M. Willie drove down at night with butter etc got papers also \$4.50 from Mrs Phillips, butter.

Cloudy morning sunny & cloudy day after splutter rain very windy P.M. Willie took 1180 lbs cow chop down A.M. 59 cts got wash mended at Barty's 10 cts P.M. we harnessed moad No. 1 and I went over some with moaden. Father up P.M. Mary down town P.M. got cough drops 5 cts harnessed 20. Returned gloves at Stubs 125 on life less 19 cts goods. Mrs Mutch paid for Mrs M<sup>rs</sup> Mitchell's hay \$5.25 Willie down
