Willie finished suffling corn and hoed some. I hoed mangel's second time P.M. A minister from Erin and another man in A.M. looking for a horse to buy. William Clark in for eggs 2 by 40cts. Joe Clark did to-day. Scherrie over in evening got 2 hens and 5 doz eggs and so on. We drove up in evening to see cattle, the water supply was dry. Several berry pickers from Elora were in Allens they had lost their way. We put loader S.D.R. and sally rake in other barn. We are still dottering Mands with dynamite.

A slight shower of rain last night cloudy in morning turned out fine sunny N.S. up all day finished hoeing turnips second time. we gave him 10.00 today which he has to work for next week. Willie and I and J. Allen up at fifty getting the water to run A.M. P.M. we hoed mangel's in N.O. Uncle Will & cousin Jim of Hamilton were in latter's auto P.M. for a while. I killed Mands with 'Patsy' and buried it in N.O. I went down town at night. Dan Indole said some of our cattle were out with
