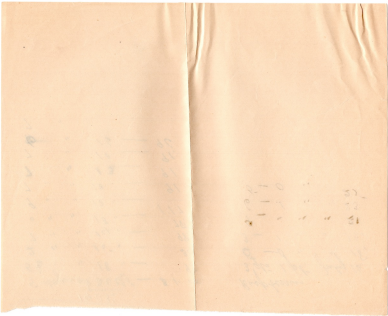

- Jan 1. Sun New Years Day, fine but very mild and sloppy. Uncle
Aunt Mattie and I at morning Church. Uncle and I
over at P's in the evening.
- Mon Jan 2. A little shower of rain then turned colder and
froze up. Father's family also Willis here.
- Tue Jan 3. Fine day but cold Uncle at Shorn hill in the
afternoon.
- Wed Jan 4. Fine day and moderately cold, took in load in the afternoon
Aunt Mattie up at Bradford, I went to Prayer Meeting in the
evening.
- Thurs Jan 5. Rather stormy and blustering, but not falling much snow
quite cold, Annie and Loggie here for tea. Uncle Aunt Mattie and
I up at Mrs Kiffers to tea.
- Fri Jan 6. Very blustering and stormy, I was at P's for a while in the
afternoon, Uncle and Aunt Mattie out to Sandhills to Mrs Wright's
lunch Party.
- Sat Jan 7. Rather stormy in the morning, Uncle and I out in the
sligh. We all went up to Willis to dinner at night.
- Sun Jan 8. Fine but quite cold, Loggie here all night, she and I went
to Fisher's. Uncle gone to Mrs Baker in the center.
- Mon Jan 9. Fine in the morning the afternoon very stormy. P's over
threshing, Mrs old Charleston dies very old.
- Tue Jan 10. P's finished threshing at noon, We started at noon, fine
day, quite cold.

- Wed Jan 11. Fine morning, but a sleet and storm in the afternoon. We finished thrashing, Uncle took Nick home. Mr. Stanton baby buried.
- Thurs Jan 12. Fine and very mild all day. Uncle at Mr. Hughes Wood Bee, then at Mr. St. Johns meeting in the evening I called at Mias in the afternoon.
- Fri Jan 13. Fine but quiet cold, sleighing very good. Bright sun shining day. Uncle brought Mr. and Mrs. Watson out.
- Sat Jan 14. Fine bright day, very frosty, Uncle out at Thornhill in the evening.
- Sun Jan 15. Fine but very cold, Uncle, Aunt Maria and I out at evening church.
- Mon Jan 16. Fine day, Miss called in the morning, Uncle out at Thornhill in the evening.
- Tue Jan 17. Fine day, Uncle and Will taking out saw logs. We went over to Mias to quilt. we did too.
- Wed Jan 18. Fine with exception of a little snow flurry. Aunt Nellie went to Toronto on the new car. We went to the library concert at night.
- Thurs Jan 19. Fine and quiet mild, I called at Mias in the morning. Uncle out in the evening.
- Fri Jan 20. Fine day beautiful and bright, I called at Jennie Hooper in the afternoon. Gables Orley here in the evening.
- Sat Jan 21. A little snow falling, but mild, we brought the children down for the day.

- Sun Jan 22. A little colder but bright and sunny, we went to morning Church, & went to Fisher's, and we all went over to P's for tea.
- Mon Jan 23. Fine and bright day, sleeping splendid.
- Tues Jan 24. Very stormy in the afternoon, Annie and Lizzie here for tea.
- Wed Jan 25. Election Day. Victory for the Conservatives. Very stormy blowing all day. Aunt Mattie came home from South.
- Thurs Jan 26. Fine but cold. I called over at Mrs. Uncle's went to South in the afternoon.
- Fri Jan 27. Falling a little light snow. Annie and Clara (Sondak) also Annie and Lizzie here for tea.
- Sat Jan 28. Fine but quite cold. Aunt Mattie went to South, to the Dentists.
- Sun Jan 29. Fine and moderately cold. I went to Concord in the morning and Uncle and Aunt Mattie to Thornhill. I went to Fisher's. Uncle, Aunt Mattie & I to evening Church.
- Mon Jan 30. Fine day. Uncle went down for Cal. Uncle and I over at P's in the evening.
- Tues Jan 31. Fine and moderately cold. Mr and Mrs Gibbons here for tea.
- Wed Feb 1. Fine day. He went to a Party at Mr. Haver's. Mr. Johnston here for dinner. I called up at Father's in the evening.

- Thur Feb 2 Fine but very cold, Annie and Lizzie called in the morning, Lizzie came over to stay all night. Auntie went to the H. S. Meeting at New Lebanon.
- Fri Feb 3 Fine but extremely cold, Aunt Mattie and Lizzie went to church. I called to see George Beard.
- Sat Feb 4 Fine this day, but cold, I called to ask for Miss Page, Annie and Lizzie went to Richmond Hill.
- Sun Feb 5 Cold east wind, Father and Mother here to spend the day, I went to Fishersville, Uncle and I at evening Church, very stormy at night.
- Mon Feb 6 Rather stormy, our lane quite deep but only light. Auntie and Mother out helping Mary Station to quilt.
- Tues Feb 7 Stormy morning but clearing at noon. Uncle went to Brooks, on the car.
- Wed Feb 8 Very stormy and cold, drifting hard in the afternoon. Will Johnston called, the last time up the lane.
- Thurs Feb 9 Fine and quiet night, I was at Mr Mc Donalds for tea. Auntie was collecting at Mr White. made out in the field.
- Fri Feb 10 Cold but very, very stormy in the afternoon Aunt Mattie and I went to church in the afternoon, I called out, Annie and Lizzie here for a while.
- Sat Feb 11 Fine day, but quite cold, Auntie went to church in the afternoon.
- Sun Feb 12 Very sunny, I was at home. Uncle and Aunt Mattie at morning Church.

- Mon Feb 12. Terrible storm, I went up to Hillside for a while in the afternoon, roads heavy.
- Tue Feb 13. Valentine's Day, snowing a little at night, drifting and extremely cold. We went to the Social Collection at Lake & ^{9:15 in AM} 59.
- Wed Feb 14. Very cold and stormy, Jinnie Cooper was buried.
- Thurs Feb 15. Drifting and blowing all day, Uncle sold a little slugging at the gate ways, Uncle at Newcomb in the evening.
- Fri Feb 17. Storming most of the day, Uncle in Toronto, Aunt Nellie over at this for tea.
- Sat Feb 18. Fine and cold, Aunt Martha and I went to Toronto, we took dinner at home we called at New Vancouver. Then went to Aunt Lynn.
- Sun Feb 19. Fine and quiet night, went to Methodist Church in the morning. Massy Hall in the afternoon, and Holy Trinity in E.
- Mon Feb 20. Fine and very mild. We called at Jinnie Spaight in the afternoon. The roads very ~~wild~~ bad for turning out.
- Tue Feb 21. Fine and very mild, the roads are almost impassable, Uncle met Margaret and Alice. Uncle and Aunt Nellie went to spend the evening with Sister Mrs Manning at New Galvanough.
- Wed Feb 22. Mild and very damp, Father and Mother here for tea the girls at the Stonehill Social.
- Thurs Feb 23. Fine and very very mild, We all went to Father's for tea.

- Tu Feb 24. Fine, mild and bright. Father, Mother and the three children called. We went for a little drive in the stage. Lizzie and Loggie here to spend the evening. She made me getting much better.
- Sat Feb 25. Fine and mild, we were at home until evening. Uncle went to Hornhill.
- Sun Feb 26. A little frosty and colder, Uncle and Aunt Nellie at morning Church. I have a cold.
- Mon Feb 27. Fine day, Margaret and Alice left. Uncle went to Court.
- Tue Feb 28. Fine day and mild, the hay men here for dinner. Auntie and I called at Mary's in the afternoon and brought Marjorie down.
- Wed ~~Feb 29~~^{Mar 1} Fine day, Auntie took Marjory over to her Grandfather's. David and Annina Tomblin here.
- Thur ~~Mar 2~~^{Mar 2} Fine day, Auntie at 20 a. Uncle at Mr. Wood's table. We went to the Convention in the evening.
- Fri Mar 3. Fine and quiet mild, two beds went out to the Convention here, we stayed, snowed a little in the evening.
- Sat Mar 4. Fine but a little colder. Mr and Mrs. Watson also left. Fisher here for tea, we had had two fine weeks for winter weather.
- Sun Mar 5. A little snow at home, Uncle and Aunt Mattie at morning Church, I went to Fisherville. Lizzie here for tea.

- Mon Mar 6 Fine day, Aunt Mathe's went to South. Brother went to Mr Charlton's.
- Tue Mar 7 Buss day, Harold Packerson has going the east stage. I was over at Mother's for tea. Very mild.
- Wed Mar 8 Fine and quiet mild. Uncle brought Mary and the children down for tea. Walter also here.
- Thurs Mar 9 Fine and very mild. Hole boys here working.
- Fri Mar 10 Fine, but old John and Mr W. Elroy called.
- Sat Mar 11 Fine and warm, quiet sleepy. I called at Mother's in the afternoon. Uncle and Auntie took butter and eggs out to Thornhill. Butter 25 cts and eggs 20 cts.
- Sun Mar 12 Fine and moderately cold. I went to Fisherville and we went out to Thornhill in the evening.
- Mon Mar 13 Fine day, I went up to Mary's for a while. Annie and Aggie here in the evening.
- Tue Mar 14 Fine and quiet mild, the snow settling nicely. I went down to Mr Sawdals for tea.
- Wed Mar 15 Fine and mild. at home all day. I have a bad cold.
- Thurs Mar 16 Fine day, the Pole boys done working here. Helen Smalley married. came a little flurry of snow.
- Fri Mar 17 St. Patrick's Day. fine day, Mr Smith taking boy away. Aunt Mathe's came home.
- Sat Mar 18 Fine until it came a little shower in the afternoon. Snow soon came out at night.

- Sun Mar 19. Fine day, the snow going nicely. The roads are not very good. We did not go to church, Uncle took some horses, Annie and Virginia here in the evening.
- Mon Mar 20. Fine day, the water over the road, but could walk over it. I could walk down the snow banks in the snow.
- Tue Mar 21. Fine day, Aunt Mattie and I went up to Willis in the evening.
- Wed Mar 22. Fine day, Uncle went to court to the opening of Parliament, the snow going, the wheels out. Mick here.
- Thurs Mar 23. Fine day, milder yet; Aunt Mattie and I went over to Father's, Mr. Watton and Mary there. Uncle came home.
- Fri Mar 24. Fine and quiet mild. Made a road down the lane with the wagon. Mick went home.
- Sat Mar 25. Fine day and warm. Uncle and I drove out to Shobdon then we brought Margery down to stay all night. The black birds are here.
- Sun Mar 26. Rained a little then cleared. We were all over at Father's for the day, the water still over the road.
- Mon Mar 27. Fine day, quiet warm. Uncle and Willie hay the ditch out so the water is not over the road.
- Tue Mar 28. Fine day, Mother and the girls here. Uncle and father out at Mary Watton's for tea.
- Wed Mar 29. Fine and very warm. Uncle brought Willie and Mrs. Chalkin down. We called over at Miss Pinner's, we called at Mother's place. Mr. Black lost his horse last night, one foot cut.

- Thur Mar 20. Fine but not quite so warm. We cleaned our cellar.
 Fri Mar 21. Fine day but dull. Miss Duncans and Mr. Sandals and
 Annie here for tea. put in one bed of lettuce
 Sat Apr 1. Fine but a little colder. We cleaned the chamber.
 Sun Apr 2. Fine day a little cold. Uncle, Aunt Nellie and I at
 Church, I went to Fishersville. then went over to father
 and brought them over for tea.
 Mon Apr 3. Fine day, we cleaned upstairs, turning colder.
 Tues Apr 4. Fine day, we painted our bed room floor, cleaned the
 parlor and spare bed room. I went over to Mother & see
 Miss Johnson. we put our onions in.
 Wed Apr 5. Fine day, we washed and cleaned up around.
 Thurs Apr 6. Cold, a little frost at night, Duncans at W. & Maudie
 I was over at Mother's in the evening.
 Fri Apr 7. Fine day but cold we put our bed room carpet down.
 I went to Show hall in the afternoon.
 Sat Apr 8. Fine and cold, we were at home.
 Sun Apr 9. Fine day a little cold. Uncle, Aunt Mattie and I
 at morning Church, I went to Fishersville. we were
 over at father's for tea. frogs out again.
 Mon Apr 10. We had a little shower, Mr Baker here to start
 cementing the cistern. Mick started work.
 Tues Apr 11. Fine and quiet warm. I walked to Show hall
 for my parcel. men did a little work on the
 land. cistern finished, cleaned most of kitchen, only
 dining room to do.

- Wed Apr 12. Fine day. Lumber at Mr White for tea. turning colder.
I went to Prayer Meeting.
- Thurs Apr 13. Fine day cold. The men cannot start work until
nearly noon as frost is heavy. Mary and the children
here all day. I went to Miss Johnsons to be fitted.
- Fri Apr 14. Fine but cold. Lumber in woods. Annie and
Lizzie here in the evening.
- Sat Apr 15. Cold with snow flurries. I called to see A. Smith.
- Sun Apr 16. Very cold, very thick ice. squalls of snow coming.
I went to Richsville. Uncle, Aunt Matthe and
I at evening Church.
- Mon Apr 17. Continuing very cold. could not work on the land
untilt afternoon. very thick ice.
- Tu Apr 18. Fine day but very cold. Miss Keffers Miss White and
brother, here for tea.
- Wed Apr 19. Fine and a little warmer. Lumber washed curtains and
things belonging the dining room. I went to Prayer Meeting.
- Thurs Apr 20. Fine and much warmer. put potatoes in garden.
- Fri Apr 21. Good Friday. Snowing most of the day very disagreeable.
Father, Mother, and the girls here for tea.
- Sat Apr 22. Fine and warmer. Snow soon disappeared. I went down
to Dr Lises, on the morning train. went to the Grand Opera
in the afternoon.

Sun Apr 23. We went to St Anns Church in the morning
and took a walk to High Park in the afternoon.

- Mon Apr 20. Fine day, I was down town in the afternoon, I came home on the evening train. Our people took Alice out.

- Mon May 1. Fine and very cold a little ice. Uncle took to Dorset for used Cate. He took the girls and I up to Richwood Hill to the Bungalow Concert.
- Tue May 2. Fine but still cold and windy.
- Wed May 3. Fine with the exception of a little shower in the afternoon. Aunt Mathe went down to the W. a. Working in Dorset, Uncle went to Dorset and stayed all night. Aunt M. called over at Mother's and Annie came over for tea. I went to Prayer Meeting.

- Thur May 6. Fine and cold. Uncle came home on the morning car.
 Fri May 7. Warm and sultry. I called at Mary's in the evening.
 Aunt Willie came home.
 Sat May 8. Rained heavily all afternoon a regular pour down. I went
 down to Mr Sprights. went to see at Mr. Jancy's bar.
 Sun May 9. Fine day. I went to the United Methodist Church in
 the morning and the Congregational in the evening.
 Mon May 10. Rained heavily in the afternoon, so I remained.
 Mr Huff. here putting in lead pipes & fixing pump.
 Tue May 11. Fine day. I spent the day with Alice and came
 home on the evening car.
 Wed May 12. Fine day and moderately warm. Aunt Mattie and
 Annie in town. I went for a drive with Uncle.
