Sunday 21st ^{fixed}

We all stayed at home
all day, as we were
expecting that Father may
pass away any time
Mrs McEachern and
Mrs Dobson came to see
him.

Monday 22nd ^{works-warn} ^{fixed}

Father died this morning
at ~~a~~ 3.15 A.M. he
passed away quite peacefully
without the slightest struggle.
Mother, Jennie Mountain,
Will & I was watching around
his bedside. After the
morning chores were done
Will & I went to arrange
for the funeral. We are
going to hold it at ~~two~~
2.30 P.M. tomorrow & paid
for digging grave, \$3⁰⁰ we
bgt Coffin, Shroud & hired hearse
& house, for, \$57⁰⁰. I bgt gro.

Tuesday 23rd Cold & damp

We Chored around in morning
and prepared for funeral
there was quite a number here
for such short notice. Father
looked very nice the most
natural corpse I have seen

Wednesday 24th fine

I went to Garden Hill this
morning. ticket \$6.50 - confere
to. Scarboro. 20⁰⁰. living at Garden Hill \$1⁰⁰
got to Mr Ritchie about 7.30 P.M.
I would like to have with
him after tea.
