I took down 6 pigs sold to Behovic Feb 20 they weighed 1130 lbs @ 5 1/2 balance @ 15⁰⁰ brought up from Beatty's 3 sets slings \$6.00 to be paid with straw. then we hauled in half load Bonanza oats from No 2 W and one load Banner from T.L. field. In P.M. Willie took load straw down to A. Armstrong 3.00 aafe got on afe 1 bag shorts 1²⁵ Bran 50¹⁰ Mutton up in P.M. stayed all night Father went to Wildmug at noon train. I went to managers meeting in church at night.
