Indications for Tonsillectomy.

R. Goldman gives the following: Recurring angina, peritonsillar abscess, cough due to an irritant tonsil, obstinate cases of Vincent's angina, primary sclerosis with the spirochæta present, tubercular and malignant diseases of the tonsil.

Also the following conditions are emphasized in which a complete enucleation of the tonsil is made; polyarthritis rheumatica, endocarditis septica, sepsis, poliomyelitis, orchitis, gout, acute and chronic nephritis, erythema nodosum, polyneuritis and chlorosis.—Arnold; Omaha.
