- 26 Fine day. Jimmie caught - buss. Bird was to Lancaster to the dentist. On the 24th I got 10 lbs green tea. 2 lbs of black. The black was 1.00 the green 3.50 - from Boyd not paid 4.50
- 27 Murdy went to Alexandria to see P. K. It rained all afternoon I churned 10 lbs
- 28 Fine day some tails of shower. Bell D. R. Mc Leman came here from Church will stay until tomorrow
- 29 Murdy came home last night - and left for North Lancaster at noon today, got 7 pan bread 20 paid for pair kid boots at Mc Crimmons Lancaster for Marion 2.25 2.25 on Friday Whitford got our potatoes
- 30 Got 2 loaves 1 box yeast - 20 cts 20
- 31 Bridie Libby & Cristy drove Sable to a W. of M. S. at Jimmie Travers, little third. We got a telegrapher to meet Uncle Sandy at Lancaster. The Kookas are still at the Hall. Last night was the first for the Misquitos in any number. Lapair got 4 bush of oats the first of week. Bell D. R. came with 3 lbs of butter I did not pay for it yet.
