C.R. scraping foundation
in morning Father stone cutting
I went to town sent
\$250 to Blake, Cash and
Cassels to pay interest on
mortgage, recd. \$68⁷⁵ 200
From A. G. H. Luxton. for 68⁷⁵
Dorset sheep, and \$74⁰⁰
From Jas D. W. @ Green 74⁰⁰
but line for Father
we planted potatoes
in afternoon.

Sunday. 2nd week
Mary, Jennie & I went
to church. heard Rev
Wills preach and
attended monthly
fellowship meeting

Monday 3rd June cool

C.R. & I cut potatoes &
planted some. Father
& Labores worked at
the foundation I shipped
1 laborer 1 day seven Dorsets. to A. G. H.
Luxton Georgetown. Freight
to be \$1¹², we planted
one bag of Clark's Seamington
potatoes Luxton to send us
\$25⁰⁰ 1.12

Tuesday. 4th June
Father & I building most
of the day J. Foley & C.R.
working at foundation &
hauling stone to us
went to see J. House about
raising barn he says
he can come in about
two weeks paid R. Short-
reed for oats. 30⁰⁰ 3000

Wednesday. 5th June
we worked at barn all
day. J. Foley laboring.
