Cool day frost last night clear all night. Mr Crow preached in a.m. from 2 Corinths 5:14. and in evening from Luke 19:13. Church Call 50cts

4 Monday  
Hard frost this morning fine sunny day got warm. Willie finished cultivating No 1 across and I sowed some commencing at C.S.R. with barley 1/2 bush trace also Lucerne treated with culture as thick as could sow it yet too thin in account of seed being too moist. We sodded round flower bed on lawn West house and dug new one along hedge planted strawberries etc. We got yesterday for butter Nellies \$1.25 - paid 25cts to mother for setting eggs. Mrs. Mutch paid balance hay \$2.70 also 15cts eggs got before.

Frost last night fine day sunny. Sold 4 1/2 doz eggs to Bunting @ 15. 67cts. We got barley and Bonner oats sowed No 1 also some New century better 8th maple tree from friend. Mr Gans over at night sowed down No 1 grass seed. Sowed alfalfa seed over again.
