Frosty, mostly cloudy snowing some. cold weather
Willie drove down brought mother up in morning
drove her down evening again. Willie dropped
some and mended plow I made pig pen
warmer put straw in back door and chookit up
etc. PM I finished plowing No 7 then furred
out on No 2. I drove up to Armstrong at night.

Thursday

Very frosty day ground almost too hard to plow today
cloudy, a little sunshine. I plowed two
furrows from culvert along top of No 5 to O.S.R.
we hauled 7 loads earth from it to water
trough end of barn and road. Mrs Cook over AM to
tell Bella to go over to her place to cut for Patricia.

Friday

More snow last night snowing all AM
soft flakes cloudy day frosty a few utters
out. We did inside work AM I made door
for straw hole in pig pen Willie cleaned engine.
PM I put large to mail box on post.
Bella over at Cooks PM also Miss Daly cutting
pagamas etc for soldiers. paid Mr Cook \$3.00 for
work at corn etc. Willie drove Mary
down PM he took bus to Forts
got bread tickets 48cts cash etc total 50cts
they both came again. Malcolm Campbell and
wife drove in in afternoon gave me a
pair stockings she knitted for soldiers. Girls
got in July P.O. for 34 cts from L.O. I & D to interest
between old and new debenture for 100.00
