The condition of emaciated patients—particularly gastric cases with obstruction at the pylorus—can often be greatly improved in the course of a few days by increasing the body fluids; e.g. a quart of saline solution administered per rectum night and morning. All patients with suspected gastric lesions involving retention of food should have the stomach thoroughly washed the morning of the operation.—Balfour; Mayo Clinic. Med. Record.
