Fine day, sunny mild. We set up the stove that Willie brought up from home in the hall and put a fire on it. Sam McKee brought over the oats he got land of August 31 also the Rye breakfast got June 22 rd. he paid freight 35 cts. P.M. J & Willie drove down I went to meeting of beef ring in Carnegie hall paid \$5.07 our share. Wm Howard up P.M. came up with Willie. I and B.A. went to Patriotic concert at night.

Cloudy, not very frosty. Willie sorted turnips etc I blocked up holes in pig pen with straws, cleaned water trough etc. Willie and Mary walked down at night Willie got at Mearns Kife 30 paid Chapman 80p for stove pipes boots got at Living overalls & smock 1.60 chere 18 got at ~~Amstrongs~~ 7 & S. money for 5 chickens 30 lbs at 13 cts \$3.90 he took down on 10th paid aft infuel sugar sent to \$2.15. he also paid M<sup>c</sup> Fadzgers aft in full to date \$14.00 chqrs on Royal Bank Willie paid Father \$10.00 on Thursday on rent I drove by chqrs J.B. yesterday \$1.00 paid it into Father aft in deb \$55 rent of Allans fifty balance on rent. Mary took butter in to Van Alpines on way down got 1.00 on it.
