April 23 in the morning the ground was covered with snow & people & children started on the land April 25 we started to pop the back field and April 30 we sowed oats and finished it the first of May was quiet warm, and of May we started to plant onions in the garden May 9 was a cold wind & May 18 was very cold & a very strong wind so far snow & later May 16. 17. 15, 20, 21 was very warm & wet but 19th was Sunday and 5th & didn't rain until 18th. 19th & 20th June 4. 5. 6. 7. was midwinter cold but still there was middays; back back or so, of June 10 July part of fruit was very hot & dry. July 9th we started planting & somewhat July 23 in the afternoon
