- 23 went to Pakenham with Fanny took dinner  
 & tea with Mr Riddle & came back to J Robins <sup>son</sup>
- 24 went to Wm Robinson then to Archibald Robinson  
 then to Mr Chellock he is married to Jennie  
 Robinson then to young John Robinsons  
 then to the old mans at night
- 25 started for home Mr Riddle came with  
 us he never at the front before came J Scotts
- 26 got home about 4 o'clock all well
- 27 went to Clinton town & heard the Revd Mr  
 Penning P preach fine day
- 28 went to Mr McCleongs with Mr Riddle  
 to see his Dog churn come home &  
 started for Brockville & saw the rail cars  
 come in Mr Riddle never saw the cars nor  
 the gass light to thought they were splendid
- 29 took Mr Riddle to Leewes to meet the stage for  
 Perth I saw him into the stage & then I went  
 to J W Haughy for A saw that we had lunch the  
 Bear she took the Bear on Saturday
- 30 drew wood fine day
- 31 Jack went to McElhenys mill with 20 bushel of B see  
 I chopped 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cord of wood at the school in the forenoon  
 I went young owls with 02 flour barrels to Clingham
