Rusting in 8 degree R's Randolph working with  
the Bell on only fine cold last night  
Randolph crept to Craig and West Longalls  
15<sup>th</sup> Snowing hard in the Marsh a Steamer Towing down the  
road we saw Black Birds at the corn shellings the crows  
Beans all eat now  
Crabs plenty 1/6  
a Picnic north  
of Bay 10 Indians  
in Madie Randolph  
Matches 10 4 lbs  
a 940 ft 13<sup>th</sup>  
fine snowing  
Fisher men 2<sup>nd</sup>  
putting in 600  
ft of Eclipse to  
done in the Louie  
Trimmed some

shot a Duck  
in the Barn  
went down at  
the same time  
from England  
Wendy brought

Randolph stole a channel boat from him  
at Hammonds 29<sup>th</sup> Moving back Marsh land drift  
the water cut 1/2 mile from town

1/3 round place a very fine 100  
and great shooting hat Lashay  
Lashay got a bit made as he had

early to day got Papers and 2

Mr. Berry and I in the Hall  
went home for a while  
2<sup>nd</sup> All Streets & Bay st. Wood  
The Steamer Alert came to  
East End of the island & ran  
anchored there they are Humber  
brought some logs to the shore  
I am going to pile them plaster  
I want 1/2 ton for our Island  
Barn the Lewis the Indian mink  
island and ran I went out  
the pole and shot at the tent  
the water very low I drew some  
to the oak field not much shooting  
I say Mr. Gandy came down for help  
The Steamer Alert came to the Island

ice going down 24<sup>th</sup>  
end fixing the Rake

rocks on the Starve Lake

26<sup>th</sup> East Wind Freez
