Easter Monday 6 at home A M <sup>April</sup> Nancy went  
to Mrs Wham P.M. Brought B & C home from  
Station as he came from Waterloo rd roads wet  
with snow & mud about 5 in snow fell last  
night going fast again, air much warmer

7 Both Piled lumber. W. Mild. roads very muddy  
8 Both Piled lumber. W. mild. Cloudy P.M.  
9 Both Piled lumber. W. fine Mild  
10 Both Piled lumber. W. fine Mild. frost even  
11 Both Piled lumber. got last logs in this evening  
W. Cold blustering wind a little snow last night  
some squalls through the day

Sunday 12 at home. A B's were here at noon B & D  
awhile P.M. & B & N at supper. W. fine Clear  
13 Both Piled lumber. W. fine Clear. looks like storm  
14 Piled some lumber A M Joe & John brought home  
a load P.M. I Chopped & went to Belford. M & N's  
were here awhile P.M. W. fine showers A.M. a  
little P.M. last night was about the first without  
frost that we have had the last few weeks

15 Finished Piling lumber & Covering Piles. we got 260  
logs cut. they produced nearly 53,000 feet of  
lumber. W. fine. rather Cold wind P.M.  
16 I & Joe sawed shingle timber in Dry Rd bush A.M.  
I & my Mother went to J D's P.M. took some butter  
to send to Toronto with him tomorrow, helped  
Joe to saw some wood in Old bush. when I came  
home. W. fine. mild Clear. frost last night

17 I & little boys drew a load of sawdust for bedding  
(straw is very scarce this spring) A.M. Cleaned gait  
& Chord P.M. Joe split wood in Old bush A.M.  
W. Cloudy Clear. snowed soft & slowly P.M.  
18 I & little boys drew load sawdust A.M.  
Joe split wood. Sawed P.M. W. fine Clear  
Sunday 29 I took Adeline & Pasanna part way to Meeting at  
Cedar Grove. J D's were here at supper B & N's came this  
evening to stay with my Mother. she does not rest very well  
W. fine Clear. looks like rain tonight

20 Cleaned <sup>April</sup> seed Oats Spring Wheat & Peas W. rainy all day  
Brought Henry Stover's daughter Christina to begin work.  
21 Sawed wood in Old bush. I went to W. Chock's <sup>this evening</sup>  
seeing to buy some suckers he has caught 1200  
in the Big Rouge since Thursday but he had none on  
hand this evening. W. Cold north wind. Clear tonight

22 I & little boys Cleaned Clover & Timothy seed I went  
this evening to see if Chod had suckers, he had none  
Joe took a bag of Peas to Cedar Grove Mills this  
morning to get Chopped & brought it home this  
evening. split wood today. W. fine Clear

23 I & Nancy & Herman & Benjamin went to M. N's  
& Simon Hooper's on a visit. W. fine Clear. pretty  
24 I & little boys went to Cedar Grove Mills A.M.  
Fulawi & J H. Bannier were here P.M. I bought  
100 suckers at W. Chock's this evening @ \$2.00  
W. fine Clear. pretty Cold air. roads pretty

25 I Cleaned & dalted fish & Joe took gait Chop & wheat  
to Cedar Grove Mills this morning then we sawed some  
drags & split few rails in old bush Joe cut wood  
in woodshed & I Chord P.M. W. stiff East wind  
began to snow from east about 3 P.M. snowing yet

Sunday 26 I & little boys <sup>& girls</sup> went to Meeting <sup>bed to</sup> at Hebron  
seems to be by R. P. Honer sermon on St. Mat. 18 Chup  
by R. H. Barker. J D's were here after service  
W. snow all went away. Mild Clear

27 Cut wood in Old bush A B got 15 bus seed  
Spring wheat P.M. W. Cold from hard last night  
28 Joe drew off stones & stumps of field opposite  
B & C's I went to see Jarvis to dig drain A.M.  
went to see Mason Preece with B & C P.M.  
W. fine Clear. frost last night

29 Chord, burned stumps & helped B & C load Potatoes  
for Toronto A.M. helped Jarvis Cross townline near  
B & C's house with tile drain P.M. W. fine Clear  
30 Pulled down old garden fence front of house <sup>had frost last night</sup> & began to  
put in new posts. I & Joe helped B & C's <sup>load</sup> load of  
Potatoes after supper. W. fine Clear. frost last night
