 for Celery Plant P.m. W. Cooler  
 4 F & H finished with team A.M. Scarborough  
 road work. they topped thistles in  
 big out field P.m. I scuffled feed  
 Corn P.m. W. fine Cool. Mary finished  
 Packing 130 lbs Butter for the Mrs  
 Wonnors today one of them came & took
