May 15 Sowed $3\frac{3}{4}$ bushel of wheat in the 2nd field & some plot & 20 bushel carrot seed had Robt horse finished the plowing & sowing fine soy

16 Granpa & David Wat Sr went Mallor town to A Swartby Meeting fine soy

plough trees in field 17 plowed John Clinghorn's garden & drew 2 loads of stuff from Weeks sawmill rain after in evening

18 Sowed $9\frac{1}{2}$ bushel of oats of the fall. rep it is killed

19 finished dragging the oats & wheat the corn & potatoes is to be planted showery weather Jack went to John Younger to help him

20 planted about 1 acre of potatoes in the 2 fields & more than an acre below the Bull pasture Robert Armstrong helped heavy rain night

21 planted $\frac{1}{2}$ acre of corn in the 2 fields in the forenoon heavy rain so that we could not plant

22 planted about 1 acre of corn below the Bull pasture on the first ridge Granpa's pumpkin & squash is planted & the 3 & 4 rows is his corn

Willard Weeks wife died last night Jack came home from John Younger he has got all sowed

23 went to the funeral of the late Mrs Weeks she was buried in countown the Revd Mr Mc Murray preached

24 the boys went to Brockville to see the performance of the Queen Birth Day heavy rain last night

25 sowed & wat went to John Younger to help him to attend the

26 went to Aunt Marys to help her about 11 bushel of wheat to mill

27 Jack & Granpa went to Granddad's place to fish

28 made two fairs for to assist in

29 went Brockville with Mr & Mrs Spencer & met Walter as he came of the Boat from Toronto fine day
30 went to Carrtown & heard the Revd Mr Mills preach

31 began to pick stones & make the wire fence on the West line laid the stones 4 feet wide put brinks on top rain at night
