- Sept 9 Thursday. doing chores finished sowing fall wheat. & harrowing. 7 W.M. away to Toronto Fair. cool windy wind. & rain at night.
- Sept 10 Friday. doing chores. finished harrowing wheat ground. & drewed water furrows cleaned same out. 7 Barlow borrowed 10 bushel boxes. I sold apples to F.B. Caldwell. of Dundas. Greenings at \$1.35. & Spyros. Baldwins & Manms. at \$1.50 also Calverts at \$1.00 per Barrel. Recd \$5.00 on account. Balance to be paid when apples are delivered at car.
