Tuesday Toward

Cloudy, sunny at times mild thawing some  
 We spread load manure on T.L. field brought  
 up load wood from bush then took box  
 load straw over to W. Match got for it \$1.00  
 In PM Willie and I went up to W.H. Barretts  
 they were not at home.

Wednesday

Cloudy and sunny, thawing. mild. We  
 mended side of box that a stem broke yesterday  
 etc in AM and In PM I took load straw  
 down to Stels and brought up load manure  
 spread it on fall wheat. Willie drove  
 Mary down in PM she got at Stels velvet 25  
 hockeys 2 at Woods Berlin wool 10 collected in W. F. M. 10  
 at D. Websters granite worn 90cts. I got bay sugar at  
 Stels in a bag \$6.25. Yarn at Woods 50cts

Thursday

Cloudy and sunny thawing some  
 Willie took another load straw  
 down to Stels and brought up load  
 manure I spread it on T.L. In PM  
 we took load straw down half to each  
 A. Stevens and Bease and brought up load  
 manure from Stels spread it on T.L.  
 Willie got at Mennies 2 ft chain 27cts  
 Willie and Mary drove down at night papers.

Friday

Frosty cold sunny day. Willie got teeth filled in  
 AM at Rids \$1.30 I took another load turnips down in PM  
 from pit. Bella and Mary at Mrs J. Wilkies for tea  
 I got at Armstrongs one qt bay sugar 10 lbs \$6.25 also bay flour.
