13. Jimmie went out for the first time since last Monday. He is auditing the Council books with D. M. Crammon
- 14 The W. F. M. S. met at G. O. I did not go it is an ugly stormy day. I called at G. O. and Mr. Guins
- On Tuesday. <sup>12th</sup> sold 1 1/2 doz eggs at Hallis for 30
- Bt 1 lb tea 25 - 1 lb black tea 25 - 1 spool thread 5
- 15 Not so cold. Pa is keeping poorly. Jimmie is not well. He got through at about 5. P. M. Murdy went for Birdie. Baked in oven

- 16 Saturday. turning warmer. Jimmie resting
- 17 Fine day snowing. went up I was out in church
