Mon 14. looked all day for Marjorie but she did not come. they finished the corn ground then went to the potato patch got it done & furrowed out & ploughed the little patch behind the bees & planted it & cut a lot of wood & mowed the grass & burnt the brush I churned 4th 3rd & put a barrel inside of Paul's ^{collar} cool
Tues 15 Marjorie came home from Chipton early in the morning Paul went to Camp Marjorie went to Chippawa after her things took. Gordon with her. 4th 2nd of butter 75.
coffee for Jan 25 corn 10 rice 5 - Yapooca 5 - 45 - 30
Paul's overalls.

Wed 16 Marjorie went to McCreedie & churned. I put the screen in the pantry window had an awful time getting the old screens off & the dead vines pulled off my window. I papered that place in the kitchen where it had not been on this spring. Arthur planted the potatoes here by the house Mrs Reesinger came down at night with Marguerite white dress she gave her for staying with her
Thurs 17. I put the wood that Paul cut in the big box washed all day. new flannel sheet, & my underwear that has been laying around so long. it rained such a beautiful rain I let the hens out but had to run after them a good deal they never went in out of the rain

carried a lot of water so much running away I got wet through twice did all my work on the rain & when I got everything done it cleared up Hattie over all night. cleared up cold wind changed to north Friday 18 I washed all the forenoon after dinner I churned Will & Arthur drawing manure I swept the two rooms & cleaned all the boards Hattie & her mother went after Eva & the little girl the little girl were over just as we were going to sit down to supper. we had pancakes. Hattie. Arthur. Eva & the children I had to sit - sponge & wash I was here. in the evening I had to sit - sponge & wash the churn

Sat 19. I baked bread. 3 custard pies. an apple sauce cake & a pie black currant-tarts. had the milking & separating to do. truly turkeys coming out. I flacked the things worthy the windows cleaned the boards again star shed a lot of cloches & moved some of them Eva & the girls went after Marjorie to the Creek. brought home some more food Gordon had
Sun 20 Mrs Russ preached his farewell sermon here Marjorie did not go to church she had a time dressing Gordon had Eva & the girls were here last night in supper. Arthur took Eva at night to Chippawa church in the afternoon she walked with Hattie in the brick Frances did not go she came over here with Mary Keavley after dinner Hattie & the girls over in the evening

Mon 21. I got the turkey pen fixed & the turkey & her young ones in it. 14 out of 21 eggs. then Marjorie's bees swarmed again & the patent-hive swarmed & went back to the hive I churned at least every one had a hand in it. the Frances & Floreny had to work at the butter. Marguerite & Gordon at school Marjorie had a big washing for Marguerite in galley room
