

1877 Betsy was buried at Countess Church Rev. W. Brown
May 16 preached from 2 Cor 5 Chap & fins 4 verses there was over 50 persons
the church was full got home at night a little rain in the morning

17 Ad made a fence for the forenoon in the afternoon we began the fence
in the afternoon it is down the middle below the barn

18 Ad & Wallace went to help Mr. Kiel to run lines

19 worked at the fence down the middle of the field
barn or nearly so we followed the old ditch
I met Mr. Nicholson at the station

20 Ad took Mr. Nicholson to Fairfax he preached here
at night Mr. Beck preached in the morning in the New Church

21 Mr. Nicholson went on the Express we worked at the fence
in the forenoon room in the afternoon fine Showers

22 we took the pine and Ad drew 4 loads of ashes
to the garden that makes 10 loads in it.

23 Ad drew 4 loads of ashes in the forenoon to the
field East of the barn Bruce McKel drew more
to the same place Ad took the roller out to
road & rolled them in the afternoon

24 Bruce drew 10 loads of ashes to the field
East of the Barn Ad loaded William rolled at home

25 Ad dragged and plowed the remainder
the garden & cut some potatoes
and dragged and drew of stone of the field East of the barn

26 Ad plowed East of the barn & planted 3 rows of
Halls beans next the house then 3 rows of butter
beans & 6 hills of watermelons I met Mr. Nicholson

27 Rev. W. Nicholson preached this morning Mr. Stewart
preached at the church

28 Ad finished the plowing East of the Barn in the
forenoon he then furrowed out the rest of the garden
& dragged East of the barn furrowed it out
& we planted the garden with the potatoes

29 finished planting the potatoes & corn I planted 4 rows of
corn & 4 rows of Sweet Corn in the garden

30 I worked at the shed in the forenoon went to Mr. Finner
at the church there was 58 rings he was buried at St. Wren Church
Rev. W. Brown preached from Rev. XIV 13 the church was full

31 I helped at the shed we got it raised up this afternoon
then appear merry than it is a little better

little rain
fine grass
time

put out 90
female
plants
I got from
Mr. Dean
& Thompson

to lay out
the shed
I helped
