Cloudy day, not warm. rained a sprinkle AM and heavy about 4 PM thunder & lightning. Willie drove down in morning he got some rods down there & he & Mary went to cemetery and put some more rocks on grave. Mary got at Stet's goods 60 ct at Shortroads meat 75 ct (got goods at Woods to be paid with eggs) Willie got wanted harness at M^{rs} Donnetts \$1.75. and boots mended M^{rs} Beth 15 ct. I finished plowing No 2.

PM we plowed Turnip Land No 2 started with long plow Willie used cross plow I scuffled most of manure. I fix d wire fence in No 4 bush after tea as the cows broke through. Mrs M^{rs} Sue in at noon trying to get us subscribe for board (Bull) we were wakened up last night by whistle blowing and found that Watsons saw mill was on fire it burnt down.

Cloudy day raining at intervals thunder & lightning. Willie took cream down in morning also 11 ct dry eggs to Russell @ 38 ct \$4.14 on aft of goods got at Dulakes points 4 14 brush 25 ct. We finished plowing Turnip Land No 2 and harnessed it Willie cultivated down half or more of manure as they were so bad with twigs grass. We got cream done \$18.46 18 46
