September 1

Thursday

Some rain last night cloudy round day a little rain in P.M. and evening. I disked stump field in A.M. and Willie disked it again in P.M. Willie got tooth filled in A.M. at Reids 50 paid M. Demott for harness etc got at C. Groves on aft 3 balls tonic @ 13cts and another costing. Bell down in P.M. got at Armstrongs spices and vinegar 53 she brought up Mrs Knox and mother for tea and drove them down again. I stoked up some more of S. field.
