1. Saturday fine warm day, 82 in shade. All our folk who were at the lawn social last night were well pleased. The volunteers came home last night - instead of today. This is Dominion day they were let off a day sooner. Jimmie did not come.
2. Fine day. A large congregation. All glad to see Mr Givin back.
3. We are busy preparing for the District Council which meets here on the 4th & 5th. Got \$2<sup>00</sup> from Murdy. Rd at Mc Crammon 2<sup>00</sup>. Butter 16 = 39. 10 lb sugar 30. 1/2 pint lard 30 1.19  
 1/4 gall molasses 12. 1 lb cocoa 5. 2 lb raisins 14 31  
 1/2 lb B. tea 20. 1/2 lb. G. tea 15. 1 cake soap 5 40

4. Fine day. The first of the guests arrived in the person of McCaskill from Van. K. Hill. and Bella & Jennett McLennan. And a Mr Craig from the Front. They were here for dinner. A Rev Shaw of Navin came to tea and to spend the night. He got 5 lbs of steak from Bronie.
5. Pa got \$9<sup>00</sup> from Snicker. Paid the oil cloth \$2.40. pumpkins 10. 2 rools of felt 65 = per yd and 3 lbs nails. There was a good meeting last night. The Convention closed at 5 P.M. and it began to rain at 9 P.M.
6. Jennett & Mr Shaw left about 9 A.M. it rained all day. There was a wild storm of lightning thunder & rain last night.
7. This is Friday before Communion. Mr Shindler from the 2d of Lancaster preached. Mr McCaskill left in the afternoon. He had several more. Made some more. August 10. good. 100 is

8. Rain all night - and showery all day. Rd Langgill preached. Paid 27 cts to Martindale butcher for last week, and took 2 lbs can saags 22. To 1 pan bread 24 cts 27

9. Rained all last night. and poured most of this day. The people were all "drunk" Rd's off \$1<sup>00</sup>. Collection Aunt Tremble and augmentation
10. Sun fine all day. made a large washing To 24 butter 36 cts. from Bird
11. Bella & Bronie went to F.D. M.L. will be back tomorrow. Marion went to Cornwall with Daisy. by train. Mrs McDonald and Mrs Taylor went also. Uncle D. sent 6 1/2 lbs of cheese by Aunt Kate's Craig.
12. Lizzie Brown & our Jimmie came by boat from Toronto to Cornwall, then by Macasson to Summers town. Lizzie brought her wheel, she took well.
13. W. F. M. J. met in St Andrews Parish. my off 10<sup>00</sup> 10
14. Fine day. kind of showery. done a small washing To 1 lb tea 30 cts
15. Bronie sent 5 lbs steak. To butter 25 cts 40 cts
16. Fine day
17. Done the washing To 100 lb one at McCrammon
18. Baked in oven. Jimmie out the meadow.
19. Murdy went to Lochiel. Marion & I went for berries. got 2 quarts
20. Look like rain. Butter at Wilkie's 28 cts
21. Stormed all last night. Thunder lightning and rain. rain all this day.
22. Dull Pot of Bronie 3 lbs steak 30. 4 1/2 lb stew butter 30. Murdy got 1 lb tea & bars of soap 15 cts. To 2 cans uncentrated lye 20. 1 gall can oil 10. sugar 15. Got butter from McCrammon for to make and cleaned it 40
