Hard frost last night cold sunny day. We took down sheep and lambs in morning separated lambs at scales 16 sold to Atkins they weighed 1850 at 4:25 came to 7860 paid for weighing 30 paid Ross Newman in full 505 got draining scoop at Websters 75. In PM Willie took 8 bags chop to Curtis and some straw to Besse then plowed Peripher town line field. I pulled and trimmed 8 rows of the #16 short rows of turnips left and we loaded them on waggon.

Very hard frost last night fine sunny day I took load turnips down in morning to scales for W. Keattie. We finished pulling our turnips to-day. I took another load down in P.M. then brought over culls thus finishing our turnips. I brought up the chop from Curtis mfg. Fatten and Charlie Young came up in P.M. Willie drove letter to C.P.R. station.

Hard frost last night cold day sunny We drove over to Keitts and bought a ram paid \$10.00 for it. In P.M. Willie plowed in V.L. field 4 horses and I finished covering pit. Mary and Bella down town in P.M. settled with Steels \$269. hay sold to Steels Bros Feb 17 \$8.77
