Wednesday November 10th

This has been a day which would have been
cold in the middle of January. The ground was
covered with snow this morning and it has been
freezing and blowing a gale from the North West all
day. We kept the cows in the stable and went out in
the waggon first thing and brought in a few shocks
of corn to feed them. George and I then drove down
town in the waggon and took some apples to Auntie
and Shuby and got some house provisions and

were around me but had to get out of the waggon &
walk to keep warm. I found Ida over there doing

of the day cleaning out the cellar and I guess had a
big job as it hasn't been properly done for years.

Thursday November 11th

Everything was frozen solid this morning but it was
a fairly nice day, we decided to cut corn. Frank went on
