

- July 1 Hot. Dry. Cool at night - soaked wet. Staps of Turnips in 2 (Pigeon) Pitting in end Port and filling Jona Round Pump took half to down to ocean
- 2 Bloody some rain. at Roadwork. Learn 2 Hands. Heavy Rain at night
- 3 Cool. Finished Roadwork. and traced 2 Endlands with Turnips in 2. Ed. came back from Joe. Garris. Rose Jones. Came up from front
- 4 (Sunday) Fine. Cool. A. Ed. & Rose to Ch from John May. Rose. Night
- 5 Shipping off and started Resting both side of Barn. A. Ed. and Rose to Elora way Cool all day. nesting rain
- 6 warm and dry. Shingling all day fine. While helping scuffed Potatoes Ed. and Rose left for Toronto
- 7 dry yet. Shingling. To Belwood to buy a 1/2 mch. Re. Calval - to Remmors ^{at night}
- 8 Shingling. to Belwood for nails Got new Boots (Paiters) Man has Finished South side of Barn 49 Bundles = 165 sp. B. C. Shingles 52 lbs 1/2 wire nails. Shingles 82-20 in sp. nails 3/4 in. U. who in Roads this will I hope take notice whether the shingles or nails last longest. My opinion is the nails will wear out first
- 9 Dry and Cool. the Crops and Pasture are badly in want of Rain finished patching North side of Barn roof. Scuffling started to thin groups
- 10 Warmer. Scuffling. Shinning in 2 fine. Late 9 May to Fagus fine to D. Thunder and a fine rain at night very much needed
- 11 (Sunday) Hot. and Blue. A. and I to Elora John. May. Eve. Thunder all round us through the Day. Heavy rain at night
- 12 breezily forenoon. Pitting in and filling Cobs. Fungus Jump. cutting shells on gravel pen 2nd to 1st line. 2400 with more.
- 13 Thirst. 2 all scuffed. Cobs in man. warm as air at night
- 14 Cool. Mon. Getting hot and battery finish shinning in 2. Scuffling in 2. Ry and 1st Fagus brown. John and Mary to party at Wright. Even
- 15 Hot. Thinning and Scuffling in 12. Thunder and Rain from 1 to 2. to Burs at night
- 16 Thirst and rain. did not come. blowing up old stack Bottoms getting Cobs. Palling manure. Scuffling mangles 2nd time
- 17 Fine and temperate all day Pitting green on Potatoes. blowing out ^{in groups} old stalks
- 18 (Sunday) a heavy rain this morning. Cobs and windy. A. laid up Lira
- 19 To Fagus. Re. H. v. summer. Lira green. Bitter Carrots &c. Pitting on Green - tone
- 20 Warm. started Haying in 4. blowing mangles. Thinning Turnips in 12. Galed up what we cut. Like Rain at dark
