20<sup>th</sup>

22<sup>nd</sup>

Sun. Fine day. Father, Miss Bruce and I went to English church this morning, I went to Presbyterian church tonight.

23<sup>rd</sup>

Mon. Fine day. Father was working at our stable today part of the time then he and Richard were drawing and mending. In afternoon I went down to S. Mitchell's for my horse <sup>Started tonight</sup> after dark.

24<sup>th</sup>

Tue. Fine day. After school tonight Mother and Miss Bruce went back to call on (bride) Mr. Philip Mellow. After they came home Miss Bruce and I went down to S. Mitchell's for tea. Father <sup>& Richard</sup> were shovelling water down to day.
