Emory broke his neckyoke coming home so we left our load on road about 6 miles from Ferguson. We got home between 11 & 12 at night started at 9 morning. Willie worked at drain etc.

I went for load tiles we left last night - got Jack shod at Brohams Elora on road back as he pulled his shoe nearly off coming up a hill over reaching. 10cts. Willie met me in clove with Lucy in buggy brought load home I drove home with Lucy got at 12 hrs 2 pairs galvanized iron boots also at can mended. got from J. Albaugh for straw he got \$1.70. In PM we finished cellar drain.
