1908

Received Paid

August 4 continued Tuesday forward  
 with some hail here had hail around  
 us several places roof blown off Kelchens  
 stable etc. Willie plowed No 7 9 AM  
 I worked at spring No 2. P.M. I plowed  
 till sent home by thunder storm. Willie  
 fixed rain. I finished letting water  
 from crib into tiledrain spring No 2  
 after tea. Willie went down town  
 at night. We got coal oil 44 cts sold  
 bags 4 cts paid for petroleum got from  
 Nichols \$1.85 including can and express.

Fine day cloudy and sunny windy.  
 Willie plowed all day No 7 7 L. I planted  
 celery in No 2 down near spring and road  
 etc A.M. In P.M. shingled barn patched shete.  
 We dipped & sucking pigs in Junolium for lice.

Thursday

Fine sunny day. Willie cut alfalfa 7 L  
 then plowed till noon. I went down home  
 in buggy to help father dig out foundation but he  
 had it done. I got at Merison of oil 10 cts  
 at Chapman's 5 lbs silver leaf twine 11 cts also  
 brought up the Petroleum from Nichols. In P.M.  
 we got binder fixed and Willie cut some of  
 barley No 1 I stocked some.

Thunder lightning and heavy shower last night  
 fine A.M. clouded over P.M. rained some  
 cleared off again. cool at night. Willie down  
 town in morning on what got it mended
