Thu Mar 28th fore part of the day cloudy latter part clear a hard frost last night. I was to see Mary Ann Siffin she is very sick

Fri Mar 29th clear and cool not doing anything

Sat Mar 30th cloudy and cool. I sawd wood

Sun Mar 31st clear and cold

Mon Apr 1st clear and pleasant. I sawd wood in the fore noon. after noon helping James Clark build a hen house

Tue Apr 2nd cloudy high wind from the East and cold. Clark was working at the hen house until 4 P M it comenced to rain. we quit work.

Wed Apr 3rd cloudy and damp. not doing anything

Thu Apr 4th clear high wind from the North and cold Clark was working at the hen house. Mrs Boyington went to Maliceburg I was house keeping

Croton April 1901

Fri Apr 5th clear and warm fore part of the day latter part cloudy. I raked the corn stalks and burnt them and a couple of brush heaps. Clark was shingling the hen house

Sat Apr 6th cloudy and soft Clark finished the chicken house

Sun Apr 7th clear high wind from the North and cool

Mon Apr 8th cloudy high wind from the North and cold. I worked at the hen house in the after noon

Tue Apr 9th clear and cool. high wind from the North. I was working at the hen house

Wed Apr 10th clear and cold. North wind again today. I went down to the old place to clean oats for J. K. Smary in the fore noon. after noon doing some trimming in apple trees

Thu Apr 11th clear and cool. I split wood in the fore noon. after noon was down to the old place trimming grape vines and berry bushes. Sarah was here last night and this morning
