We spread 2 loads manure No 2 corn land. Mr Faucet over in evening got hay on wagon paid \$3.00 for it.

Don took sick in roller Willie drove down for J.M. Fudge who gave him a bath and got his hand hurt doing it Willie drove him down again.

Willie and May drove down at night Maud in buggy May stayed down. We paid M.H. in full 75.5.
