was cutting smut and weeds out of  
the corn.

ing weeds and smut out of the corn.

Wed Aug 17<sup>th</sup> cloudy rain this afternoon  
which is much needed. I finished  
cutting smut and weeds out the  
corn this fore noon.

Thu Aug 18<sup>th</sup> clear part of the day and hot.  
I was cutting up thistles in the fore noon  
after noon went to Dresden with John  
W. Snarey. Walter took Rose & Mary to  
to Shamesville this fore noon. they are  
going to Michigan on a visit. after  
noon commenced plowing for wheat.

a great deal to day.

helping John W. Snarey make fence  
this fore noon, after noon commenced  
to cut up corn. Walter finished plowing  
the little field for wheat.

Wed Aug 24<sup>th</sup> flying clouds, high wind  
from the North and cool. I was cut-  
ting up corn. Walter was harrowing  
the the ground for wheat.
