- Sat Sept 17. Fine and quite mild, out without coats all week and no need of fire Lorraine sick with jaundice. Wed
- Sun Sept 18. Fair and quite mild, at morning Church, John, Felicia and Verner called, Mylicia Lizzie and children and Annie for tea.
- Mon Sept 19. Fine and a little cooler, I made jelly, Mrs D. helped me, <sup>washed for cleaning</sup> Tue
- Tue Sept 20. Fine with exception of a squall in afternoon cooler. Annie here at night, went to Bloor St. furs \$10. two Mink furs and old Cape, got small basket of peaches 75-cents canned in afternoon. Thur
