Saturday 12th fine Will & W.B. Cut wood. and I went to mill for chop and got a load of Barley. at 51^c per bu. 51 bu 37^{lbs} @ 51^c = \$26⁴⁰

I recd prize money from Rhos \$85⁰⁰ money for Carcase & hide 8⁰⁰ pd w. Batty 5⁰⁰ all hauld. 30^c
