His brother went down on Monday. He was ill about 2 weeks altogether. I went in to see Rena in the afternoon and then went to the library where I worked until half past six. Practised  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an hour. Wrote to Dorothy and wrote an address to be presented to Mr. Heinmiller by the chosen friends. Went down to the house about a quarter to 9 to read "Business to Business" to Mrs. Bunker. Quite mild. Shampooed my hair in the morning.
