

Jan 27. dull day. Fannie went to the brick got a ride with Preesingers. we had stewed hen & pot pie for dinner. Fannie & Arthur over in the evening. Jan 28 Paul took \$5.00 in bill from 28, not cold a very nice day. muddy roads. Will went to Chippewa, nomination day. Marforie baked bread & I churned & worked the butter. Marforie washed out a few things near night - (29) Marforie got 1.50 cts of bran

Jan 29 a grand day beautiful sunshins all day. Drawing wind west. Marforie went to Drummondville took 3 lbs butter @ 28 - 140 & 9 egg @ 35 pdy - 27 to the 9 - 1.67 bag of salt - 10 black tea 15 - matches 12 Pearlin's soap 15 - walls 10 and 5 arches up in room to Grechies sewing room the children gone to Montague. Will gone to Mrs. Bell's to see about selling a pig. I swept & dusted the school house. in poor little Baby kitten took her entrails all dragging was done with all her little cunning ways. The day was to struck out for awhile when Rab. Preesinger was to come to afternoon but did not catch much water. School morning Marcy Bell went in again. Paul killed 3 hens & a little rooster for Willie. moonlight & breezying tonight - Then 31 sunshins on the horizon they butchered two little pigs for Willie. Fannie & her mother went in the afternoon & took out chickens the 3 hens & one little rooster weighed 13.77 @ 12 & 9. In the same 13 shillings & 3 d. just paid for the bran \$2.40 over. one poor little kitten was buried. cold & stormy in the afternoon when they were coming home, was freezing up a lot.

January 1909

Friday 1. Beautiful sunshins all day. cold wind & high I went over to Mrs. Preesinger had dinner & supper, they had a chicken for dinner. Rab & Mary came home with me & came in Troy was there too she looked fine. Fannie cut Marforie's skirt at \$1.2. Marforie baked bread & swept the front room. I washed dishes all forenoon after dinner churned worked the butter, swept & the kitchen & cleaned it blacked the stove after Fannie & therefore went to Preesingers at night. In see about the teammeeting Sun 3 looks like a storm sprinkled rain Paul & the children went to church Marforie did not feel like going they had a boat about the teammeeting Anna Marshall came home with them from church. (Will killed a pig on New years for Mrs. Bell. took 1.00 on sal)

Sun 4. dull in the morning but the sun struck out nice. The children started to school. 6 new scholars started. Anna Marshall here to dinner. I churned after dinner & worked the butter. Arthur went to Rue Hardy. Will over this evening Jan 5 roads wind east when I went down to help Marquer sweep. I swept over half & dusted. Marforie washed & colored Marquer's dress & her two waist's had to iron them dry Paul walked to Chippewa took 6 lbs butter @ 24 - 15.00 got an egg 80. tea 30. Pens 5 - Thread 10. Rations 10 candy 5 cents - shot 10 stamps 1. Marforie sent a separate list for silk & lining Wed. 6: sunshine & gloomy in the afternoon Fannie here working on Marforie's skirt took Reels dress home to make over. Will & Arthur killed a pig for Mr. Coopers. wind change in the night: from east to north west & bitter cold & changey Fannie Marshall went home

Then 7 wind north east & bitter cold all day Paul baked the east side of the house got the bereau on the front room
