- 7 I made the syrup hot and put away 3 gall in a demijon. It began to snow about 11 A.M. now 4 P.M. it has ceased sleighs can run. Birdie went with May to Lancaster
- 8 Cousin Mary brought us 1 gall fine syrup. Annie Campbell called
- 9 I did not go to church. Pa had the D. to give some tonic. got 1 lb tea at Walker 43cts 43
- 10 Sap ran fine today. boys all in bush. got 5 lb brown sugar 25cts. at J. A's. gave the 2cts on Sunday to Henrietta M. Arthur. May & Daisy took tea here 27
