Sat Apr 7th clear wind from the North West and cold. I went to Florence this fore noon to get money for Victoria. I saw some has commenced to plow. those dry cold winds is beginning to tell on the wheat

Sun Apr 8th clear and pleasant.

Mon Apr 9th clear fore part of the day cloudy this evening I was boiling Sap. Sugar of about 20 lbs this evening. the best run of Sap to day we have had this Season.

Tue Apr 10th a wet disagreeable day we cleaned up some peas for Mr Hartwick this fore noon. Victoria was married this Evening. the girls all here but Alice.

Wed Apr 11th clear and pleasant over head wet and mud under foot I took Ira and Victoria to Shamesville this fore noon they started for Buffalo. I was boiling Sap this after noon.

Broton April. 1888

Thu Apr 12th cloudy and cold some snow in the fore noon after noon clear. we were cleaning up peas in the fore noon after noon I was trimming current bushes

Fri Apr 13th cloudy a prospect of a storm. Walter and I was repairing fence this fore noon after noon was boiling Sap. finished Sugar making for this Season.

Sat Apr 14th cloudy wind from the North and cold. was splitting stove wood and cleaning wheat the fore part of the day. latter part I took the wheat to Shamesville and exchanged for flour.

Sun Apr 15th cloudy Snow in the after noon

Mon Apr 16th clear and pleasant. I was trying my hand at Soap making. there was about an inch and a half of snow on the ground this morning. no sowing done here abouts yet.
