July 1 Boy's Scuffled & had Corn
I took Susanna to Boy's after
dinner & brought her home this
evening Boy's began to dig a grave
for these kids. Hilt's daughter after
supper N. very very warm about 90
2 Boy finished grave till about 9 A.M.
Then they had Corn we all went to
General of Hilt's daughter about 2 P.M.
3 P.M. I don't know the name of the
Preacher he had to preach outside
Mrs Hilt's was too much overcome
to go inside. The weather was very
warm I think about 90 deg. There
are some Thunder Clouds going
Susanna was at home alone a slight
shower this morning.

3 Boy finished having Corn & began thin
ning Pumpkins. Henry helped Boy's draw
in hay A.M. M's Mary went to P. B.
to dinner N. some cooler clear
4 I mowed a few acres in Meadow till
about 10 A.M. mowed along fences Henry
thined Pumpkins A Scuffled Mangel
& Henry had Potatoes. P.M. I took
mist to Br D's A.M. N. pretty warm
not so warm as it was a fine shower
about 4 P.M. heavy Thunder showers went around
John's Mary & I went to St Drudges. P.M.
