- Thur Sept 5. Fine afternoon. but dull cold. wind very black, Annie and I walked out to order corn at Mr Fowlers.
- Fri Sept 6. Fine bright day but cool. Aunt Mattie went to Mr Streets.
- Sat Sept 7. Fine and cool. I had all my Quilts and Pillows out on line yesterday. I called at Mr. Watsons. Auntie. and I up to order butter at Mrs Littles. - a heavy shower in eve.
- Sun Sept 8. Fine and warmer, Aunt Nellie at morning church. Aunt Mattie at mothers in afternoon. then Mr Davidson took us for a ride. and had tea out on third. Aunt M. and I ^{Church} eve.
- Mon Sept 9. Fine bright warm day. we all went to Toronto got my suit. 24.75[#] and extra for alterations. I called at Aunt Eggies with corn Aunt M. and I at Mr. Cooks. having, Jato Mortgage extended. for five years. I walked to Mr Streets in evening. went without Coats.
- Tue Sept 10. Fine but much colder but very bright. I went to Weston.
- Wed Sept 11. Raining gently. and warmer, did Elderberries, & Crab Marm
- Thur Sept 12. Showery most of day. Annie here in the evening.
- Fri. Sept 13. Very heavy rain at noon then cleared in afternoon. I got a pair of Chickens at Mrs Littles \$1. each.
