- Nov 1 Went to Lynn to an Agriculture Meeting the <sup>points</sup> Bull ~~to~~ bye Nov 17
- 2 the Revd Mr Kenning preached in caintown
- 3 began to pull the Turnips the Revd Mr Morrison & James Hamilton came here from Brockville & stopt 8 9
- 4 all night Toches very bad with the Rheumatism 18
- 5 worked at the Turnips fine weather
- 6 very heavy winds last night with a little rain finished the Turnips good crop drew in the corn stalks very cold day
- 7 drew 5 load of wood cold day
- 8 drew in some potato in the forenoon went to a plowing Bee of George Enels
- 9 drew in load of potatoes it rained most of the day went to Lynn with Father to the Quarterly meeting there was a terrible squall about 1 o'clock of wind & rain 19
- 10 the Revd Mr W. Murry preached in caintown
- 11 drew in some potatoes put 2 loads of cups in our seller & 1/2 load of them went to a plowing Bee of Mr Heylwood in the afternoon cold day 2
- 12 killed the Hogs Wm Davis & Paul helped we killed 5 for us & 1 for eyes 2
- 13 went to Brockville with 1 hog got 7 3/4 per cwt & 1 barrel of apples got 2 barrels for cider from A. Turner 2
- 14 drew some wood & fixed the Cab-log
- 15 dragged 1 part of the potato part & began to plow it
- 16 satted the pork & made it Barrel of croust the boys plowed
- the Revd Mr German preached in caintown hard frost last night 20
