- 12 Tuesday. Began to storm about 6. A.M.
- 13 Very cold Mercury down to 22 Had a letter from Randy
- 14 Boyd was here on Tuesday and we took 5 lbs Japan tea 35 for lb 1.75 - 4 lbs Black 50. 3.75 Pa. got at Willis 5 lb currants 25. Green sugar 75 Harriet killed 4 hens for me this evening
- 15 Still cold Whulford drew the last of the poles that Far cut last fall. Got 25 for load. 4 loads in all. Sent \$40⁰⁰ to Ran borrowed 25⁰⁰ from Dunlop \$10⁰⁰ from D. Bush I had a letter J.C. He will be home next Thursday Evening. turned stormy
- 16 Snowed & stormed all night. Rain and sleet all day Harriet killed 7 hens and plucked the feathers Got 1 gall wolf oil 15 D. Dougald was telling us that the St. Lawrence is frozen over
- 17 I was not in church
- 18 I made a small washing
- 19 Cold
20. I was not at Prayer Meeting
- 21 Jimmie Brown. came home this evening
- 22 Ran came home
- 23 We got a box of oranges from F Robertson. Ran brought them from the Gore Birdie came home Murdy went to the Gore for her. began to rain
- 24 I was not in church. Rain and drizzle
- 25 Warm. but mist and rain
- 26 J. C. Bird Marion Murdy & Ran were all at the concert last night. The Falkners surpassed themselves. proceeds \$31⁰⁰
- 27 School meeting at Ross up the river, is the new trustee in J. R. Paine's place. Every man or voter in the place is attending
