- 10 A fine cold day to call coal oil 20 2 loaves 14 34
- 11 Some snow today 70 4 lbs butter 30 per lb 81.20 - 1 doz buns 1 30  
Murdy went to Alexandria bag of rolled oats 30 30
- 12 Mrs St Thomas paid \$2<sup>00</sup> Gave Eugene 1 pail potatoes for cleaning the hen house, 2 corn brooms 35-40 75
- 13 Soft snow. at noon came down heavily, now 6.30 P.M. very high wind 70 2 loaves 14<sup>cts</sup> Murdy not back yet  
This is Murdy's birth day

- 22 Stormy day. John and Agnes were down, Kate's Christmas

70 2 lbs butter 70<sup>cts</sup>
- 24 Turned soft - 20 coal oil 20 loaf 6 26
