- 16 Betsy was buried at Courtouse Church Rev. W. Brown, preached from 2 Cor 5 Chap & vers 4 & vers 8 there was over 50 tears the church was full got home at night a little ^{rain} ^{in the morning}
- 17 Ad. made ^{for} a fence this forenoon we began the fence in the afternoon down the middle below the barn
- 18 Ad & Wallace went to help Mr. Kiel to run lines
- 19 worked at the fence down the middle of the field farm or nearly so we followed the old ditch I met Mr. Nicholson at the station
- 20 Ad took Mr. Nicholson to Fairfax he preached here at night Mr. Beck preached in the morning in the ^{New} church
- 21 Mr. Nicholson went on the Express we worked at the fence in the forenoon noon in the afternoon five shows
- 22 worked the pine and Ad drew 4 loads of ashes to the garden that makes 10 loads in all
- 23 Ad drew 4 loads of ash in the forenoon to the field East of the barn Bruce McKel drew more to the same place Ad took the roller out to the road & rolled them in the afternoon
- 24 Bruce drew 10 loads of ash to the field East of the Barn Ad loaded Walla rolled at home
- 25 Ad dragged and plowed the remainder of the garden & cut some potatoes ^{shovels} and dragged and drew of stone of the field ^{of the} ^{barney}
- 26 Ad plowed East of the barn & planted 3 rows of Halls beans next the house then 3 rows of butter beans & 6 hills of watermelons I met Mr. Nicholson
- 27 Rev. W. Nicholson preached this morning Mr. Stewart ^{at} ^{night}
- 28 Ad finished the plowing East of the Barn in the forenoon he then furrowed out the rest of the garden & dragged East of the barn furrowed it out Walla & me planted the garden with potato ^{except} ^{3 rows}
- 29 finished planting ^{the potatoes} & corn & planted 4 rows of pop corn & 4 rows of Sweet Corn in the garden this forenoon Ad drew stones from the foundation of the shed at the church & he got his outside barrel
- 30 I worked at the shed in the forenoon went to Mr. Finiers farm at the way 58 rigs he was buried at the Wilson Church Rev. W. Brown preached from Rev. XIV 13 the church was full
- 31 I helped at the shed we got it raised up this afternoon then a great many then Ad is a little better
