- 5 2.30 P.M. It is beginning to look bright and it is very pleasing to the people. The bridge on the creek at the foot of our garden is impassible two washouts on it
- 6 Saturday more rain
- 7 Fine day looks like fine weather
8. I baked some cornbreads. got 20 20 Made a washing. Jimmie ploughed the garden Murdy took his cloth to Maggie
9. Made a butking in oven. Pa & Jo caught 4 1/2 doz perch
- 10 Done a little work in garden. sowed onions. Ran sowed Mangolds hats carrots and turneps. one row of each. between the apple trees. Hot 84
- 11 I am not well. And Birdie is sick had Felt now to see her. Diphtheria
- 12 Very hot 86. On Wednesday gave whitford 1 bush <sup>wheat</sup> & 2 bush barley 6 bush oats Got 3 bush potatoes at <sup>town</sup> ~~Sumner~~ 2.10
- 12 I do not feel well Bird is some better
- 13 Jimmie sowed 2 bush wheat. it drizzled all day. crooked in the house
